

## How to make a Photograph with your Film Canister Pinhole Camera

**ONLY 1 PHOTO CAN BE TAKEN WITH THIS CAMERA. DO NOT REMOVE THE TAPE UNTIL YOU ARE READY TO TAKE YOUR PHOTO AND NEVER REMOVE THE LID!**

1. Find a Subject
2. Put Camera on secure surface with black tape facing subject
3. Check Exposure Guide for time
4. Gently remove black tape while keeping camera and subject still
5. The Black Tape acts as a shutter... Removing it exposes the film inside the camera
6. Replace black tape over the Pinhole after the elapsed exposure time
7. Done! You just made a Pinhole Photograph.

**REMEMBER: This is a one time use camera... Only one(1) Photo can be taken... Keep the black tape on the pinhole and put back in the ziploc bag with name, email, & shipping address, and return to Primal Photographic for developing.**

### Pinhole Film Canister Exposure Guide Approximations

**NOTE: Pinhole Photography is not predictable... These are suggestions, don't worry about perfectly exact times... Use your instincts and just have FUN!**

BRIGHT SUN, SNOW, SAND  <b>2 - 5 SECONDS</b>	BRIGHT OVERCAST CLOUDY DAY  <b>10 SECONDS</b>	HEAVY OVERCAST CLOUDY DAY  <b>30 SECONDS</b>
DAWN OR DUSK  <b>2 - 5 MINUTES</b>	LOW LIGHT INDOORS  <b>1 - 2 HOURS</b>	CITY LIGHTS AT NIGHT  <b>1 HOUR</b>
